Cleaning: All products best cleaned in a dishwasher, alternatively scrubbing with hot water and detergent. Allow the product to dry thoroughly before storage. Wood components can be lightly scrubbed and dried.

Oven, microwave and freezer:

The use of the microwave and freezer pose their own challenges, while the products in the Charlotte Watson range are used successfully, the manufacturer cannot accept responsibility for any resulting problems, due to the porosity, that may occur to product or persons.

CHARLOTTE OVEN TO TABLEWARE

Do Not use on cooker hobs or any other direct heat source.

Oven: Maximum oven temperature 260°C / 500°F. Use hand protection as dish maybe hot.

Microwave: Handles may become hot during microwave use, use hand protection.

Freezer to oven use: Do not put a frozen dish in a pre-heated oven, allow the dish and oven to heat together.

Cleaning: Before use wash the dish in hot soapy water then rinse and dry. For most cleaning, cool the dish then wash and dry, or wash in the dishwasher.
